Tietie Cooperation - Information Technology Education Using Information Technology

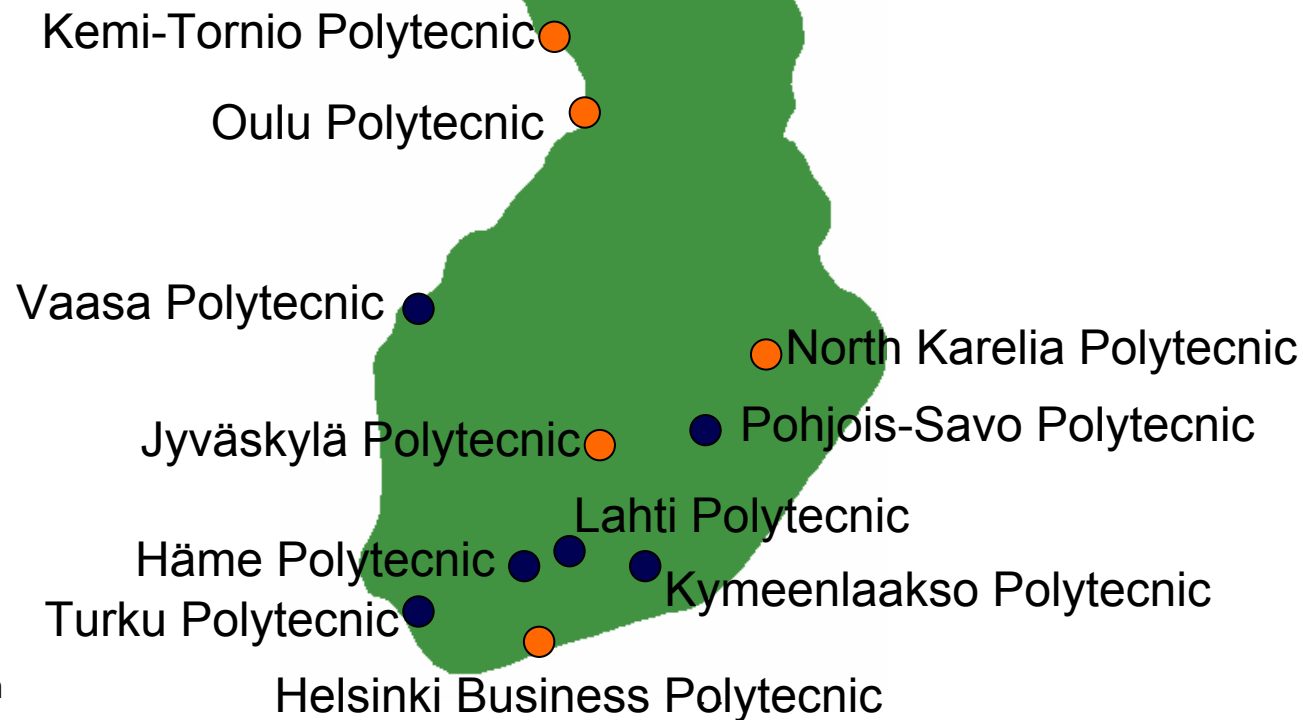
- **The participants are students and lecturers in degree programmes of Business Information Systems in bachelor level education.**

Cooperation Partners

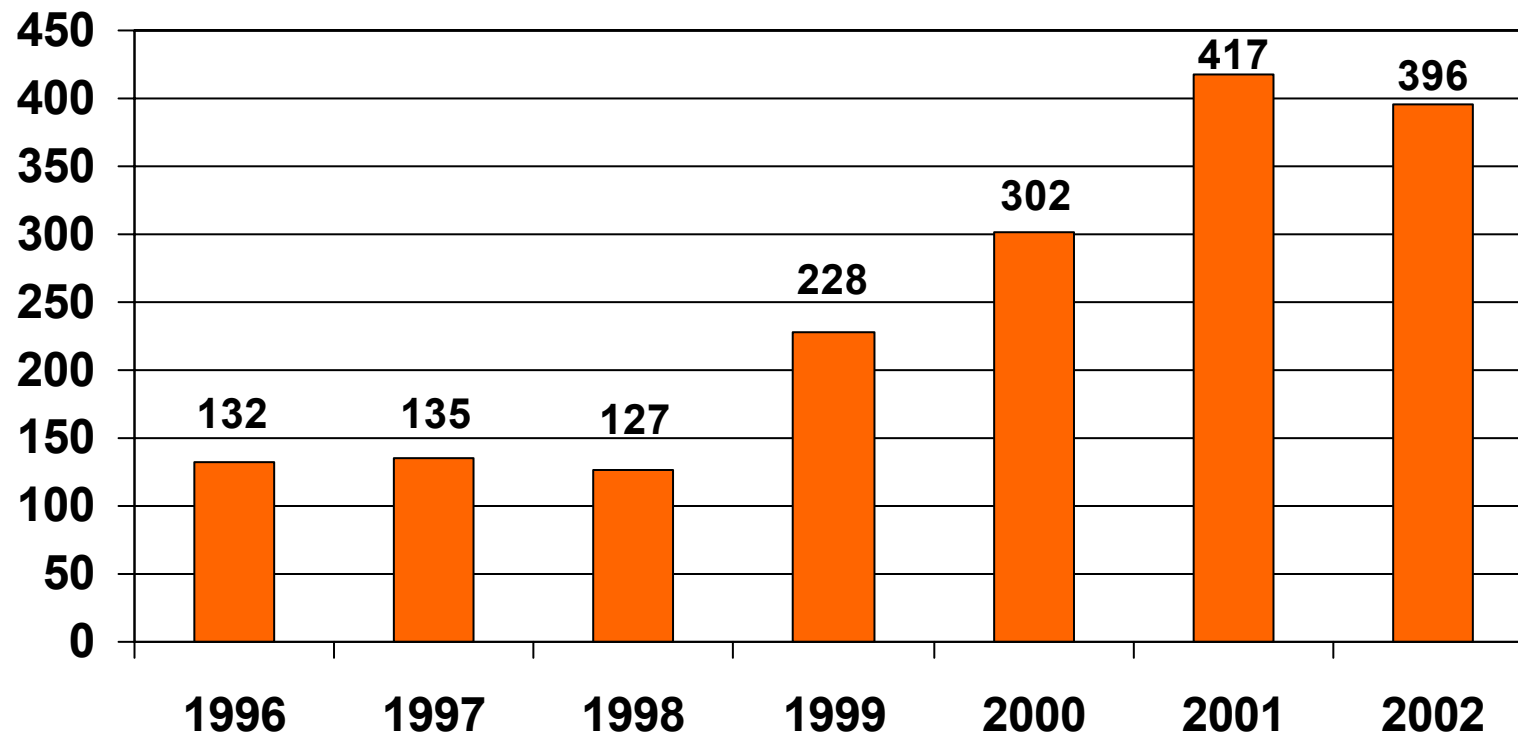
- during the project (still partners)

Roles

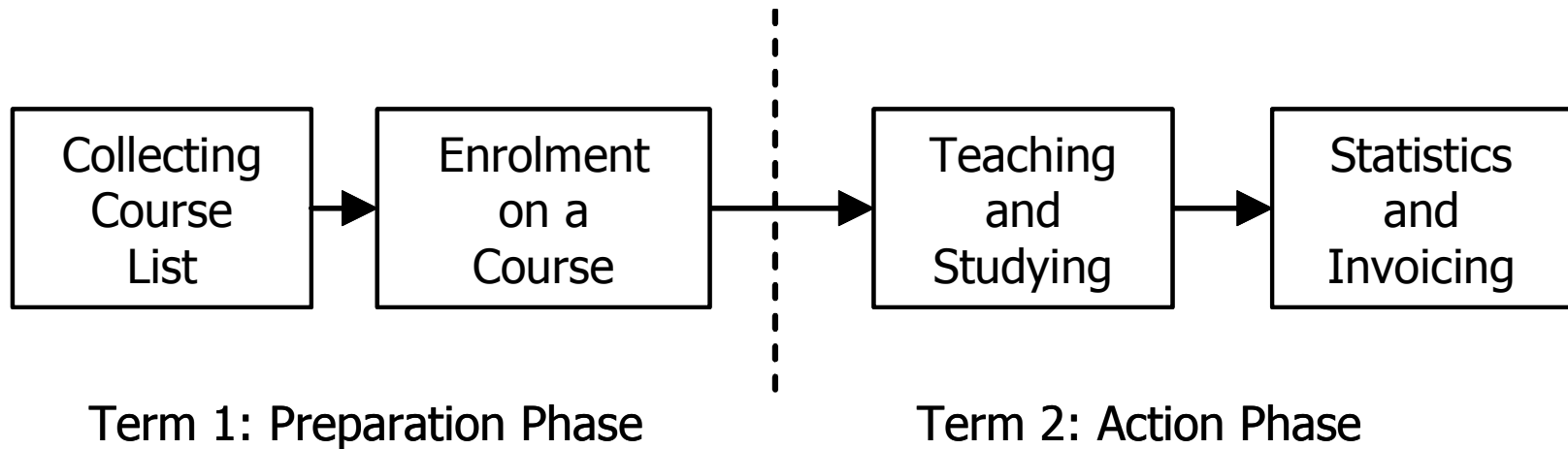
- A network coordinator - one in the whole network
- a local coordinator – one in each polytechnic
- a lecturer – several in each polytechnic
- a student – several in each polytechnic

- The home polytechnic of each student

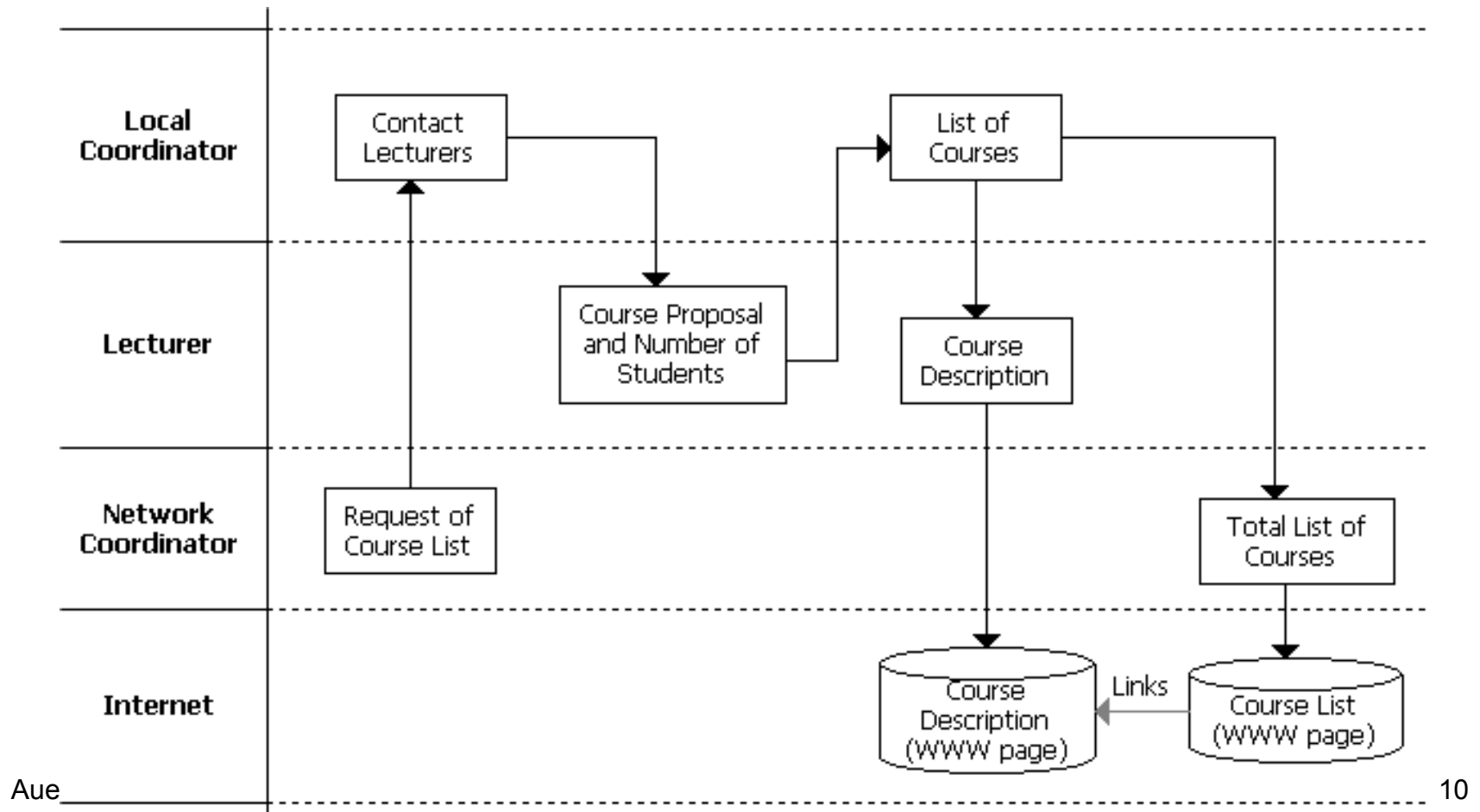


Processes and Terms



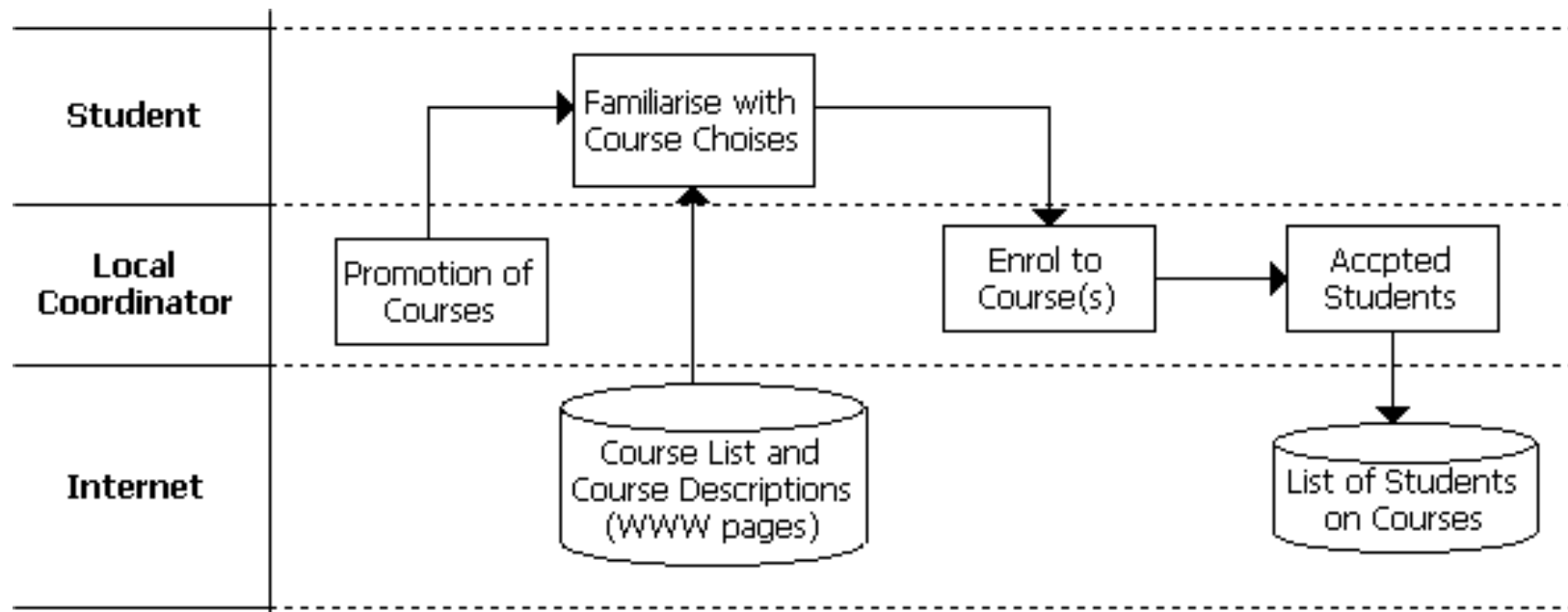


Collecting the Course List for the Next Term



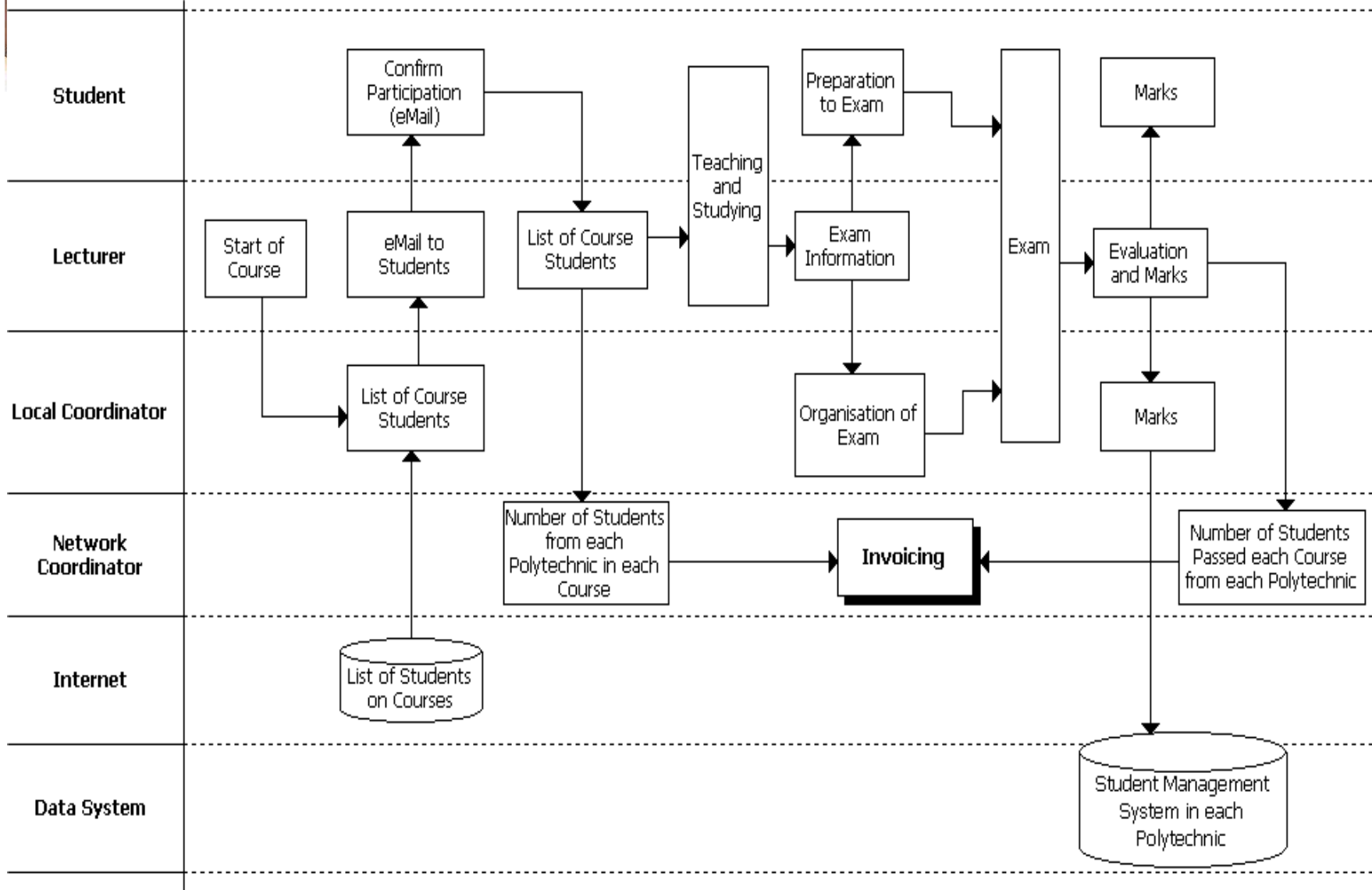


Enrolment on a Course

Why Administration Process has Succeeded

- The participants have trusted each other both in administration and teaching.
- For this reason administration became light, although the administrative processes are complicated.
- The administrative model is distributed.
- All the participants have access to all information in Tietie cooperation.



Considerations of eLearning

- **Students prefer contact courses.**
- **eLearning is attractive, if**
 - **a corresponding contact course is not available**
 - **the student is not able to participate in a contact course**
 - **the student is very self-directed and he/she wants to have a strong control of one's life**
 - **the student's life situation pushes him/her to choose courses that are not dependent on time and place**



Finally

- **We assume that the mainstream of education in the future will be contact teaching and learning, but this will be enriched by eLearning.**
- **A successful implementation of eLearning requires also new kind of administrative processes to be developed, especially if several independent institutions are involved.**
